

**SUBJECT: THE DAY OF REDEMPTION**

**SCRIPTURE: Ephesians 4:30. "And grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, by whom ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.**

**INTRODUCTION**

**The Day of Redemption is related to a future time in which Believers' earthly body will be glorified and changed into the likeness of Christ's glorious body.**

- Philippians 3:20, 21. For our citizenship (conversation) is in heaven, from which also we look for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, Who shall **change our vile (lowly) body, that it may be fashioned like His glorious body**, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things unto Himself.
- 1 John 3:2. Beloved, now are we the sons (children) of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be, but we know that, when He shall appear, **we shall be like Him**; for we shall see Him as He is.

**The Lord Jesus Christ's sacrifice for man includes the redemption of that person in his entirety; in every area of the life – spirit, soul and body.**

- 1 Thessalonians 5:23. And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God **your whole spirit and soul and body** be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Hebrews 7:25. Wherefore, He is able also to **save them to the uttermost** that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever liveth to make intercession for them.
- 1 Corinthians 6:29, 19. What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost who is in you, whom ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For **ye are bought** with a price; therefore, glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

**This redemption begins when a person places their faith in Christ.**

- Psalm 107:2. Let the **redeemed** of the LORD say so, whom **He hath redeemed** from the hand of the enemy.
- 1 Peter 1:18, 19. Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver and gold, from your vain manner of life (conversation) received by tradition from your fathers. But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

**By the eternal life that we have received in Christ, and by the Holy Spirit, God will continue the work which He started in each Believer until its completion at the Day of Redemption.**

- Philippians 1:6. Being confident of this very thing, that He who hath begun a good work in you will perform it **until the day of Jesus Christ**.
