

JESUS CHRIST REVEALED

1. Through the Word of God

- a) God the Father speaks about His Son (Jesus); Genesis 3:15
- b) God the Son speaks about Himself: “I, Wisdom...” Proverbs 8:12 - 36
- c) The entire Word of God, in some way, reveals Jesus Christ: “Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me) to do thy will O God.” Hebrews 10:7

2. Through the Old Testament:

a) Prophets.

- The Suffering Savior, Isaiah 53
- Zechariah, Zechariah 14
- The Sun of Righteousness, Malachi 4:2

b) In shadows and types throughout the Old Testament:

- Melchizedek (Genesis 14:18)
- The Tabernacle (Exodus 25 – 27; Exodus 36, 37)
- Joseph, a type of Jesus Christ (Genesis 37, 39 – 45)
- Jonah, Matthew 12:30; Luke 11:39

c) In Christophanies/Theophanies (preincarnate appearances of God the Son):

- The “3 Hebrew Boys” saw: The Son of God (Daniel 3:24, 25)
- Joshua saw: The divine Captain (Joshua 5:13 – 15)
- Ezekiel saw: The glory of the LORD (Ezekiel 1:26 – 28)

3. Through the New Testament:

- a) At the incarnation: John 1:14
- b) At His Baptism, Matthew 3:13 - 17
- c) His public ministry. Acts 10:38, 39

4. After His resurrection

- a) Acts 10:40, 41
- b) John 21

5. At the new birth – Matthew 11:27; Acts 9:1 – 6; Eph 1:17 – 19; Ephesians 2:4 – 9; 2 Corinthians 4:6

6. In the book of Revelation – Revelation 1:12 – 20; in the seven churches of chapters 2 and 3

7. At His second coming (in power and glory) – Daniel 7:12 - 14; Matthew 24:30; Revelation 19:11-16. *It is at the second coming of Christ that He will be revealed simultaneously to everyone! Revelation 1:7*
