Answer the following questions from Hebrews 10:1 – 10:

**HEBREWS 10:1 – 4**

1. What three things does verse 1 tell us about “The Law?”
2. According to verse 1, what is the word which is opposite, “shadow?”
3. From a dictionary, look up the meaning of “shadow” and the meaning of “image.”
4. If the sacrifices of The Law could have “made perfect” what would had been the results according to verse 2?
5. The opening verses of Hebrews chapter 10 tells us that the sacrifices of the Old Testament were offered often. According to verse 2, what were the continual sacrifices meant to remind the people of?
6. Hebrews 10:4. “For it is \_\_\_\_\_ that \_\_\_\_\_ of bulls and goats can take \_\_\_\_\_.”

**HEBREWS 10:5 – 7**

7. Because the sacrifices of the Old Testament could not make perfect and could not take away sin, what did Christ Jesus do? (verse 5) “Therefore, when \_\_\_\_\_ the world.”
8. What did God, the Father prepare for His Son? “A \_\_\_\_\_.”
9. From a dictionary, look up the meaning of “sacrifice” and the meaning of “offering.”
10. Did the sacrifices of The Law please God?

  - a. According to Matthew 3:17
  - b. According to Acts 4:10
  - c. According to Philippians 2:9 – 11
12. What is the one key theme of the Bible, according to verse 7?
