

The Sanctuary and Sacrifices of the New Covenant
Hebrews 9:11 – 15

The following questions concentrate on the work of Jesus Christ as our Great High Priest. The emphasis is from Hebrews 9:11 – 15. Complete the following exercise for a better understanding of these verses.

1. A High Priest serves in a tabernacle. According to Hebrews 9:11, what type of tabernacle did Christ serve in?
2. In Hebrews 9:11, the phrase, “not of this creation” is in contrast to what words in Hebrews 9:1?
3. Hebrews 9:12. With what sacrifice did Christ enter into the Most Holy Place?
4. According to Hebrews 9:13, what do these animal sacrifices accomplish?
5. Hebrews 9:14. What does this verse tell us about each Person in the Godhead (God, the Father; God, the Son; God, the Holy Spirit)?
6. According to Hebrews 9:14, what does the blood of Christ accomplish on our behalf?
7. How was the new covenant officiated, according to Hebrews 9:15?
8. What does the new covenant give to those who are “called” by God? (Hebrews 9:15)
9. Ponder verses Hebrews 9:11 and 12. At what point in time did Christ accomplish this work?
10. Comparing Hebrews 9:11 – 15 with Hebrews 9:6 – 16, how does the priesthood of Christ exceed that of the Levitical priesthood?
11. The New Testament title “Christ” is mentioned four times in Hebrews 9 (verses 11, 14, 24 and 24). According to Psalm 2:2, what is the definition of this title, “Christ?” How does Daniel 9:25 translate the title “Christ”?
12. What do the following verses tell us about “Christ”?
Luke 2:26; Luke 9:20; John 6:69; John 20:31; Acts 9:22
13. Hebrews 9:11 says, “But Christ came as High Priest.” According to Hebrews 5:1, 4 – 6, how is it that Christ became High Priest? How was He made High Priest according to Hebrews 7:20 – 22?
