

Elementary Principles of Christ *REPENTANCE from DEAD WORKS*

Hebrews 6:1 – 3

“Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of **repentance from dead works** and of faith toward God, of the doctrine of baptisms, of laying on of hands, of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. And this we will do if God permits.”

Whether in the Old Testament (OT) or in the New Testament (NT), you do not have to read very far to see the doctrine of repentance come to the forefront. In the OT, the common word used for repentance was “turn” or “return” to God. In the NT, repentance is preached from John the Baptist. Afterwards, the Lord Jesus Christ follows with the same message. Likewise, the Apostles continue, throughout the book of Acts and the Epistles, saying the same thing: “Repent.” And, yet, even now, in our day, according to Acts 17:30, “God commands all men everywhere to repent.”

Repentance means to “change one’s mind.” It is a change in one’s mind concerning God and the ways of God. It is a turning away from sin and from one’s own way (“dead works”) and a turning to God in faith. This “change in mind” results in an outward change in actions.

Repentance is one of the major themes of the Bible. Its thread runs from Genesis to Revelation. For further study, from the New Testament, study the following references:
